### **Important information concerning exams:**

1. ALL BOOKS MUST BE TURNED INTO THE COMPUTER ROOM PRIOR TO WRITING YOUR EXAM. Ms. Bettencourt will be available in the Computer classroom beginning at 8:15 and 12:15 each day the exams are written. If you do not return your textbook, you will not be able to write the exam.
2. Middle School Students – Grades 6, 7 and 8 will write their exams in the Senior Lunch Room. Grade 6 will be writing year-end tests. Middle school exams will be 1 ½ hours in length.
3. High School Students – Grade 9 – 12 will write their exams in the Auditorium
4. All students must BE ON TIME for the exam. Any student who misses an exam or is late may not be given the opportunity to write the exam—a zero will be given for the exam.
5. If a student is sick and unable to write an exam, they must provide a doctor's certificate.
6. Depending on the subject, exams may be scheduled for three hours. Teachers will be preparing exams that are at least two hours in length. Some exams may be three hours.
7. All FINAL EXAMS will be written in the Auditorium.
8. Exams will be placed on the desk prior to the students entering the exam room.
9. Students will sit where they find the exam they are writing.
10. The exam period will be a minimum of two hours in length.
11. All students must remain in the exam room for at least one hour—no dismissals before 10 a.m. or 2 p.m.
12. No student will be allowed to leave the exam room during the final 15 minutes of the exam.
13. Once students complete the exam they are permitted to leave the school.
14. All students should return their test to the appropriate teacher and sign out (with time) when leaving the exam room.
