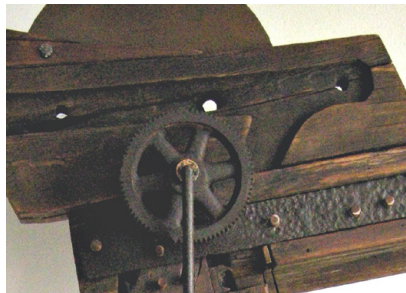

# REGISTRATION & PAYMENT POLICY GUIDELINES

## Registration

To register fill out the registration form in print and send it along with payment to KAF via the following methods: (partially filled out forms will not be accepted)

- Walk in delivery
- Email – education@kaf.bm
- Fax - 542-9010
- General Post Mail – KAF PO BOX 735, Devonshire, DV04

**Please Note:** Class placement must be secured at the time of registration via 50% deposit or full payment otherwise your registration will be considered a hold, which will be released after 5 days if the required payment has not been made.

## Holding Class Placements

Because of the popularity of many of KAF's classes placement can only be held for 5 days without the security of payment. If the placement has not been secured by the end of that time the student's name will be taken off the class roster.

**The following are required to hold placement:**

- Student's name
- Guardian/Parent's Name (if applicable)
- Daytime contact number or email

## Payment

A minimum of 50% for deposit is due at time of registration to secure placement for classes. 100% of the payment for classes is due the week before classes start. Students whose class placement has not been fully paid by the beginning of the first week of the term may be removed from the class roster.

## Cancellations

Up to 30 days before a term cancellations can be made with out monetary penalty. Providing that the class placement cannot be filled, refunds for cancellations will be distributed as follows:

- 75% refund at 30 days before the start of the term
- 50% refund at 10 days before the start of the term
- 25% refund after the start of the term
- 0% refund after the first class

Students/Parents do have the option of transferring funds for cancelled classes for another term or class.
