Mount Saint Agnes Academy will be offering a tour of Canadian Universities in November 2010. The tour will include Universities in the Maritime Provinces, Quebec and Ontario. The Universities included on the last few tours were:

Nova Scotia:

Dalhousie and Kings, Acadia, Mount Saint Vincent, St. Mary's, St. Francis Xavier

New Brunswick:

Mt. Allison and University of New Brunswick

Quebec:

Bishops University and McGill University

Ontario:

Western and University Kings College, U of T, York

Ryerson, Seneca, Queens, McMaster, Guelph, Brock, Niagara College, Waterloo, Sir Wilfred Laurier

If there is a University not listed that your son/daughter would like to visit it can be added to the tour. The tour will take place around the midterm break in November.

A deposit of \$500 will be required by June 18th. The number of deposits received by this date will determine if the tour is offered. This deposit can be made in cash, check or card (Accounts will process your payment if you are using cards.) and checks can be made to Mt. St. Agnes Academy.

The total cost, dates and itinerary will be provided when it is confirmed we have sufficient numbers for this tour. The approximate cost of the 9-10 day tours in the past was \$2100-\$2400. An installment plan will be established once it is confirmed the tour will proceed in November.

The last two MSA University Tours were a huge success. The students found it a rewarding experience. All agreed that the visits helped them decide which university would be the best fit for them. The tour enabled students to compare campuses, programs, residences and other services. They also gained an appreciation for the location of each of the universities and they were able to see campus living from the perspective of students attending the university. All factors play an important role in choosing a post secondary school.
